DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED: OBSERVATION 1

Your cosmetic was prepared, packed, or held under insanitary conditions whereby it may have become contaminated with filth.

Specifically,

- 1) On 03/12/2018 I observed reactor (b) (4) located in the manufacturing room with an open lid while (b) (4) for Men Shampoo + Conditioner Lot# 18J0308038 was held inside as an in-process product.
- 2) On 03/12/2018 I observed residues of products in the upper part of reactor was performed to it on 03/08/2018 and a re-cleaning performed on 03/12/2018. Reactor was ready to process a new batch of hair care product. The lid of reactor was open. Reactors and was open. Reactors are located next to each other.
- 3) On 03/12/2018 I observed white hoses used to pump product to the hopper of the filling lines resting on a table near filling line The hoses were already cleaned and sanitized and both ends were without the protective caps that serve as a method to prevent contamination, leaving the interior surfaces exposed to the environment.
- 4) On 03/12/2018 a personal item (employee jacket) was stored in close proximity to filling line (b) (4) Black Shampoo + Conditioner Lot# 18J0308039 was being processed in this line. The jacket was specifically located next to the air hose used by this filling line and a white hose used to fill the hopper with a product.
